Greetings! We hope this letter finds you well and in good spirits. We are thrilled to invite you to our upcoming **Annual Meeting on Wednesday, May 15th at 7 pm in the large community room downstairs at the Greenville Library.** It's going to be an exciting evening as we discuss our projects and select our Board Members and leadership for the coming year. We would be honored to have your participation.

WHAT WE ARE UP TO THIS YEAR

- **MAY 4th PARK DAY.** We have been hard at work continuing to improve trails at Vanderbilt Park. Coming up next Saturday is our MAY 4th PARK CLEANUP DAY. We would love to have your volunteer support. Feel free to contact us at (518) 256-1157 to sign up. Volunteers meet in Vanderbilt Park at 9am to noon.
- **ARTS IN THE PARK.** Our artist members are busy organizing the first **on May 18th** in Vanderbilt Park (rain date May 19th) Our aim is to highlight the incredible talent that resides in the northern Catskill and Hilltown's region centered around Greenville, while also driving more traffic to our local retail businesses. We believe this will be a wonderful addition to our community's cultural landscape and are proud to support our local artists.
- **SAVE PREVOST HALL.** We are working with the Town of Greenville to restore Prevost Hall to use as a community center. The town hired a firm to draw up engineering plans for the work needed on the building, with the expectation that work can begin on the building this year. CPOG is also helping the Town with implementing a \$100,000 grant from Senator Hinchey's office to complete the restoration of the stained-glass windows and we are working to secure another large grant to aid in the second phase of the repairs to the building. It is expected that the full renovation of Prevost Hall will continue thru 2026. If you are interested in helping the Town with this project and haven't contacted us yet, call 716-572-7064 to join the Prevost Hall Committee. Fundraising for this event may include another Greenville Fiberglass Duck project around Town during the summer of 2025.
- **SUMMER CONCERT SERIES.** Our successful concerts at the gazebo in Veterans Park, next to the Greenville Library, will continue this year. On subsequent Tuesday nights in July and August, you can enjoy a variety of musical artists. A schedule will be posted at www.cpog.org and on Facebook in June. Don't forget to bring a chair and join us for these delightful evenings of community camaraderie, live music, a food truck, and ice cream when available.
- **GREENVILLE DAY 2024.** Thanks to the generous support of our Town, business community and CPOG members, last September we worked with the Town of Greenville to organize a fantastic Greenville Day weekend that drew about 3,500 attendees! Families in our community enjoyed free carnival rides, a craft and business fair, fireworks, music, and more. Discussions are currently underway on how CPOG can best support the Town's 2025 Greenville Day weekend September 27-28 through fundraising and volunteer assistance.
